Parish Appeals: (i) The Sanctuary Arch. Thank you for two further anonymous donations of £50. We now have £7,247.49 in the Sanctuary Arch fund, an increase of £4,134.77 in 3 months towards the £9,000 (50% of the total cost plus, we hope, £9,000 grant). (ii) The Boiler Room (£10,073). This week we have received an anonymous donation of £8,000 to cover the complete cost of removing the asbestos from the Boiler Room. We are extremely grateful to our anonymous benefactor and the work will take place from Thursday 20th—27th October. This means that, including £8296 in the General Parish Account we now have £32,435.07 in our Parish Account (Eighteen months ago we were £23,000 in debt!).
