Parish Finances: Unfortunately, our general parish fund is severely depleted. Having spent nearly £8000on removing the asbestos from the boiler room, we now have only £22,253.13 in the parish account. Of this, £19,494.94 vis set aside (and can only be used for) the new boiler, taking down the chimney and repairing the sanctuary arch. This means we hgave only £2,758.19 in the general parish account. Please keep our parish in your prayers! Many thanks for the very generous donation of £500 last Sunday taking our general parish account to £3,258.19 (less payment of March bills and invoices).
