ADVENT 2021

Catholics in England and Wales are being encouraged to vision the Advent Season this year as an opportunity to return to the Sacrament of Confession and (for those who have not yet returned to the celebration of Mass) an opportunity to re-connect with the on-going life of the Church. To facilitate (and encourage) this return, on each Tuesday evening in Advent the 6-30 p.m. Mass will be followed by a time of Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, and the opportunity for Confession – finishing at 7-30 p.m.

Also from Advent Sunday (this Sunday) after the 10-30a.m.Mass there will a regular Sunday meeting (of about 20 minutes/half-an-hour) for all those preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation. From Advent Sunday, the homily at Mass, over the coming months, will take the form of catechesis on the central tenets of the Catholic Faith as together (with those preparing for Confirmation) we remind ourselves (and recommit ourselves to a deeper understanding and appreciation) of the foundations of the Christian faith. Come, Holy Spirit!

Please, therefore, continue to keep the life of our two parishes in your prayers as we enter, through Advent, into a particularly busy time preparing for First Holy Communion and for the Sacrament of Confirmation, as well as the Tuesday Advent Confession/Adoration Masses and the Parish Synod Meetings. May God bless us in all these things and strengthen and renew us through the Holy Spirit reviving and empowering us as we commit ourselves to a more active co-operation with, and consecration to, God's Divine Grace at work within us.
