HOLY WEEK AND EASTER

Through the Forty Days of Lent we have been making our way towards Holy Week and Easter following the Stations of the Cross and participating in the Self-Offering of Christ, through our smaller acts of sacrifice and self-denial. Today, Palm Sunday, we arrive with Jesus at the gates of Jerusalem and with Him enter the Holy City. On Thursday we gather in the Upper Room for the Mass of the Lord's Supper and follow to the Garden of Repose. On Friday we gather at the foot of the Cross – "we adore Thee, O Christ, and we bless Thee, because by Thy Holy Cross Thou hast redeemed the world" and await, through Holy Saturday, the Glorious Resurrection of Christ on Easter morning – "He is Risen indeed! Alleluia!". May this Holy Week be a time of renewal and grace for us all.
