

SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER – 12th APRIL 2026

(DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY)

During these forty days between the Resurrection of Jesus and His Ascension in to Heaven, we rejoice in the truth and the power of the Resurrection – **“He is Risen! He is Risen indeed! Alleluia!”** The Risen Jesus rises through all our preconceptions and presuppositions, challenging us to look again at how we see the world – and how we **experience** it. Are we living “in the world” - or are we living “in Christ” and “from” Christ? Jesus invites us to situate ourselves within His Resurrection Presence – to “abide” in Him, as He invites us to do. May we open our hearts and our homes to receive Him in all His Resurrection power over this glorious Eastertide!
